The City Council Meeting agenda was mailed or emailed to members of the media and posted on the bulletin board at the Lake City Municipal Complex.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Anderson, Jr. called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Lovith Anderson, Jr gave the Invocation. Councilmember Sondra Fleming-Crosby led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Lenessa Hawkins polled the Council and found a quorum present.

I. MOTION TO ADOPT THE AGENDA

Mayor Anderson requested a motion to adopt the Agenda as published.

A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Cook and seconded by Councilmember Sondra Fleming-Crosby to adopt the agenda as published. The motion carried unanimously.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Mayor Anderson stated that the next item is Citizens Comments which are limited to two minutes per person and no personal or verbal attacks will be entertained. The Council is interested in hearing your concerns, but speakers should not expect Council action or deliberation on subject matter brought up during the Public Comment Period. III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Pursuant to Section 30-4-70(a)(2) to discuss negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements with respect to the collection and disposal of refuse and recycling.

A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Cook and seconded by Nicole Singletary to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Section 30-4-70(a)(2) to discuss negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements with respect to the collection and disposal of refuse and recycling. The motion was carried unanimously.

An Executive Session was held.

A motion was made by Councilmember Tony Whitlock and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Billy Brown to come out of Executive Session. The motion was carried unanimously.

IV. FOLLOW-UP ACTION FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Cook and seconded by Councilmember Tony Whitlock to accept the proposal of American Waste Systems to provide refuse and recyclable goods collection and disposal services to the residents and businesses located within the City based upon the recommendation of the City Administrator and to authorize the City Administrator to proceed with contractual negotiations. The motion was carried with Councilmembers Wilhelmena Scott, Sondra Crosby, and Nicole Singletary opposing.

A motion was made by Councilmember Tony Whitlock and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Billy Brown, Jr. there being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m. The motion carried unanimously.
