1. Ordinance 2016.420 – Second and Final Reading

A motion was made by Councilmember Tony Whitlock and seconded by Councilmember Richard Cook to approve Second and Final Reading of Ordinance 2016.420 authorizing the execution and delivery of an agreement by and between the City and American Waste Systems, Inc. for the provision of solid waste and recycling management, collection, hauling, and disposal services within the City; and other matters related thereto.
